Does Not Exist

- No process, polices, management in place
- No systems

Adhoc

- Process, policies, and management are developing
- Manual approach to monitoring

Committed

- Limited process, policies, and management, but not an organizational priority
- Limited system data available, (PDF and outdated)

Formal

- Formalized process, policies, and management
- Separate data being pulled from multiple sources

Managed

- Drug diversion department established who owns process, policies, and management
- Limited integration of systems data

Optimized

- Drug diversion department fully supported by organization. Process and policies are regularly updated with education tools in place
- Proactively using a state-of-the-art monitoring system on a daily basis
